We are almost 100!

For the last few months, I have been hoping to make this announcement: "100 members in the Nordkap Lodge!" Since January last year, we have gained 18 new members which has outpaced the number of members leaving us. Per September 1 report we are now officially 99 members as we gained one and lost one in August.
