Criteria for Consideration

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a lodge member (for minimum 1 year prior to scholarship application), or child/grandchild of a person who's been a lodge member for a minimum of one year prior to scholarship application
- Be 17-23 years of age
- Be working towards an associate's or bachelor's degree from an accredited educational institution (students working towards their first degree will be given preference)
- Be in good academic standing at school, have a GPA of 2.0 or better

Special Notes

- You may qualify up to 4 times for this scholarship.
- Scholarship amounts will be based on the availability of funds and may vary year-to-year.

<u>To be considered complete</u>, an applicant shall submit the following information to the scholarship committee:

- A completed application form, signed by the applicant
- An account of participation in Lodge and other Norwegian cultural activities
- A current transcript from your College/University or High School
- Proof of High School completion (i.e. Diploma copy; if applicable)
- A copy of your original post-secondary acceptance letter (if applicable)
- Short written summaries answering the following four questions:
 - 1. If awarded this scholarship, how will you spend the funds received?
 - 2. What are your long and short-term educational and professional goals?
 - 3. What do you think is the value of belonging to an organization like Sons of Norway?
 - 4. How will you continue your involvement with Norwegian cultural activities in your life away from home?
- Copies of two current letters of recommendation (written within the last year) as they were
 originally received as emails or hard copies. These can be related to volunteer community
 service, participation in extra-curricular activities, academics and/or employment.

All applications and supporting materials MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN June 30 of the year of application. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
